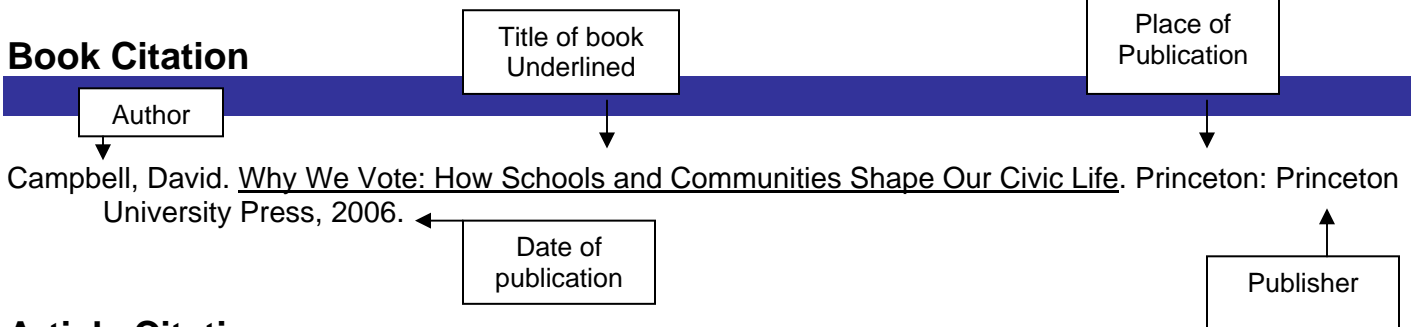


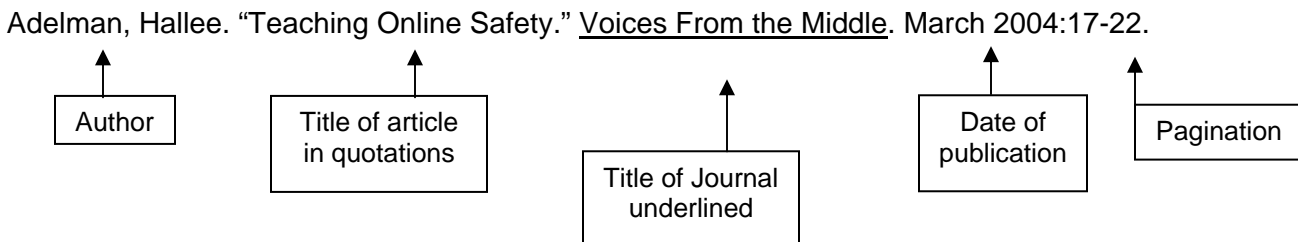

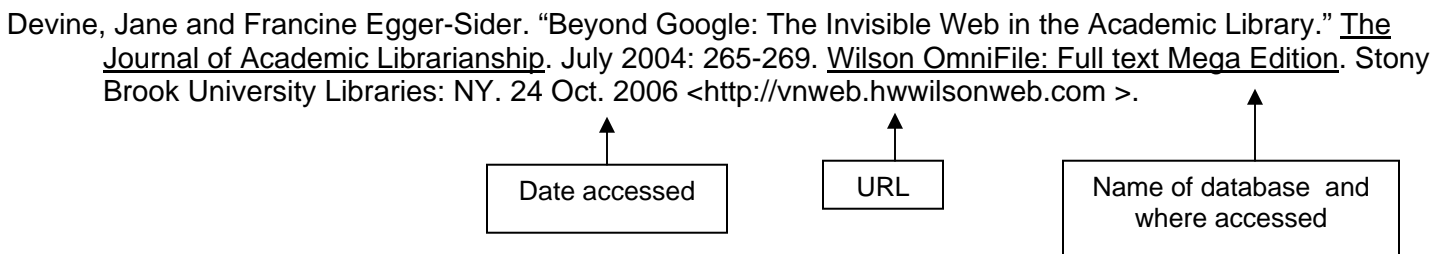

### Article from a **print journal**

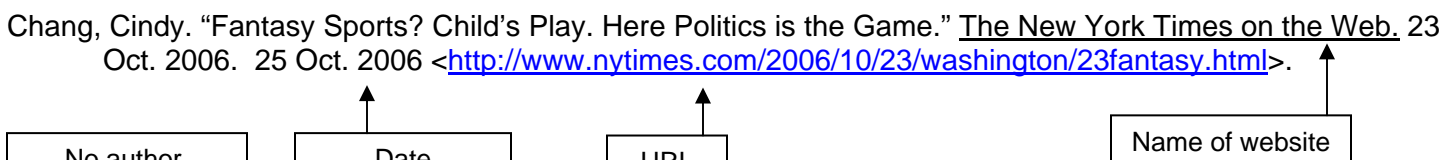


### Article from **an online subscription database** (2 authors)

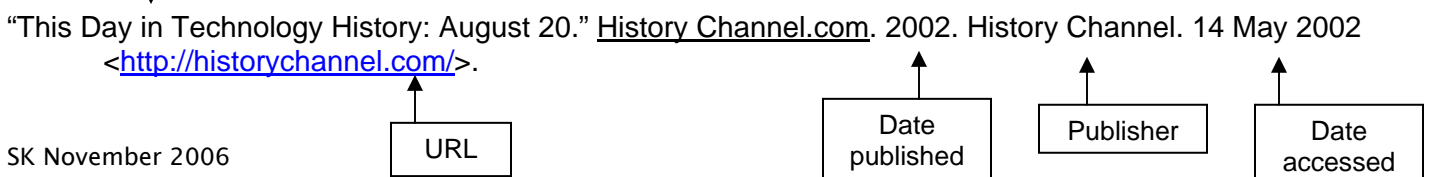

# MLA Citation Style

For complete information on how to cite a source, consult the text below.\*

- Always check with your professor as to which citation style to use.
- Arrange all items alphabetically by author; if there is no author, use the title. Indent the second and following lines 5 to 7 spaces.
- For some sources there is a URL (uniform resource locator: internet address.) Always include the date the site was accessed, even if a website contains no date.
- An important goal of citing sources is for a reader to be able to find and consult the actual source.
- Because electronic sources are subject to change and error, it is suggested that you print out all sources.
